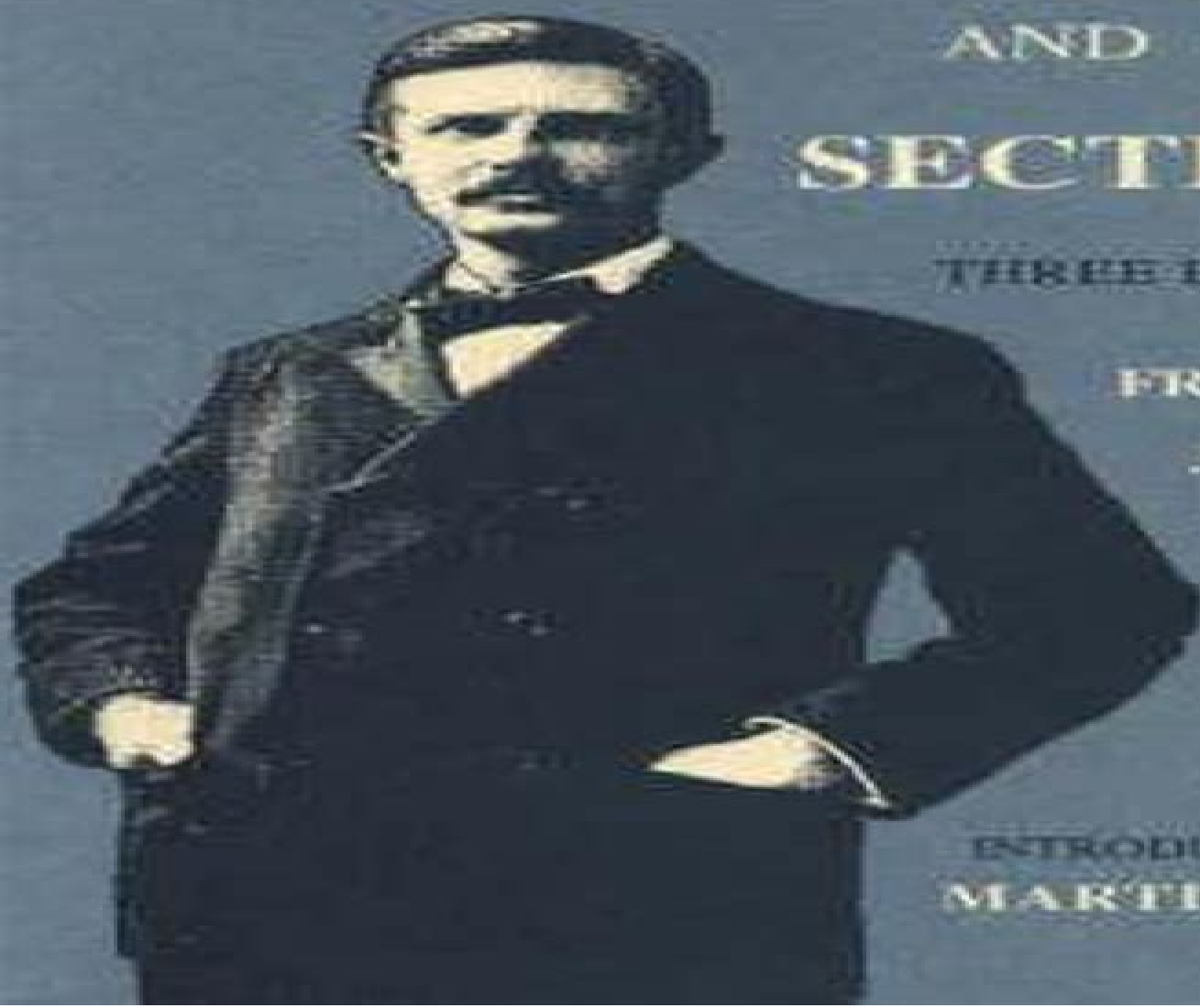

as much influence among historians as his frontier thesis He argued that different ethno cultural groups had distinct settlement patterns and this revealed itself in politics economics and society His other works include *The Character and Influence of the Indian Trade in Wisconsin* 1891 [Encyclopedia of Local History](#) Amy H.
