Before he died, Saussure told friends he was writing up the lectures himself, but no evidence of this was found. Eighty years later, in 1996, a manuscript in Saussure's hand was discovered in the orangery of his family house in Geneva. This proved to be the missing original of the great work. It is published now in English for the first time in an edition edited by Simon Bouquet and Rudolf Engler and translated and
