

Element Of C

The elements of C are the basic building blocks that are used to create C programs. These elements include:

Keywords - Keywords are reserved words that have a special meaning in C. They cannot be used as identifiers. Some examples of keywords are `int`, `float`, `while`, and `if`.

Identifiers - Identifiers are names that are used to refer to variables, functions, and other objects in a C program. Identifiers must start with a letter, and they can contain letters, numbers, and underscores.

Constants - Constants are values that cannot be changed. There are three types of constants in C: integer constants, floating-point constants, and character constants.

Literals - Literals are constants that are represented directly in the source code. For example, the integer literal `123` is a literal, as is the floating-point literal `3.14159`.

Operators - Operators are used to perform operations on data. Some examples of operators are `+`, `-`, `*`, and `/`.

Statements - Statements are instructions that tell the computer what to do. Some examples of statements are `if`, `while`, and `for`.

Comments - Comments are used to explain the code in a C program. Comments are not executed by the compiler, and they are ignored by the computer.
