Argumentation Mining Manfred Stede, Jodi Schneider, 2022-06-01 Argumentation mining is an application of natural language processing (NLP) that emerged a few years ago and has recently enjoyed considerable popularity as demonstrated by a series of international workshops and by a rising number of publications at the major conferences and journals of the field. Its goals are to identify argumentation in text or dialogue to construct representations of the constellation of claims supporting and attacking moves in different levels of detail and to characterize the patterns of reasoning that appear to license the argumentation.
