DEFINITION

Countertransference refers to a therapist's emotional reactions and projections towards a client, often influenced by the therapist's own personal experiences or unresolved feelings. It can arise from the therapist's response to the client's transference or from the therapist's own personal history.

EXAMPLES

- Over-Identification: The therapist relates too closely to the client's experiences, seeing themselves in the client and blurring professional boundaries.
- Parental
 Countertransference: The therapist begins to relate to the client in a parental manner.
