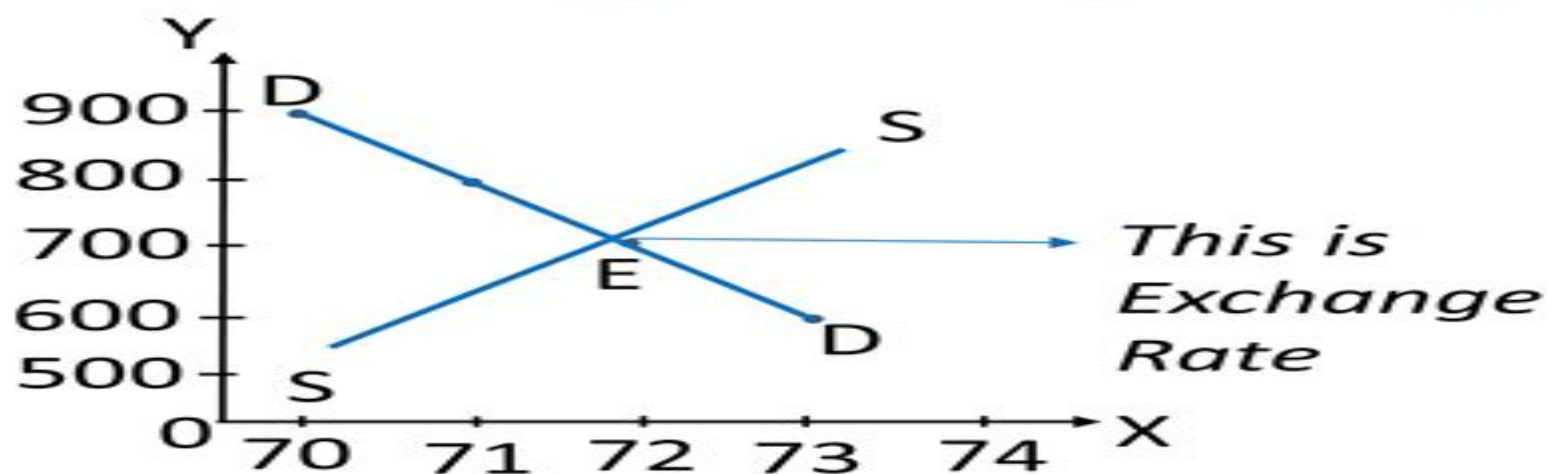


Graph Representation of Flexible (Floating Exchange Rate)
