accommodated into an MHC molecule This challenge can be overcome by T cell cross reactivity that is the ability of a single TCR to bind multiple peptide MHC complexes T cell cross reactivity can have both positive and negative consequences First it allows for covering a wide range of foreign peptides with a limited repertoire of T cells Second it facilitates polyclonal immune responses to a single peptide and increases resistance to escape mutations Third it can induce heterologous immunity that is the generation of memory to a pathogen different from the one against which the immune response has been originally raised On the contrary a negative consequence of T cell cross reactivity is the possibility of self antigen recognition potentially causing autoimmunity The lower activation threshold of memory T cells compared to naive T cells increases this risk partially eluding the thymic negative selection checkpoint Moreover heterologous immunity can be detrimental when the type of memory T cell polarization induced by the first pathogen is inappropriate to control the second pathogen
