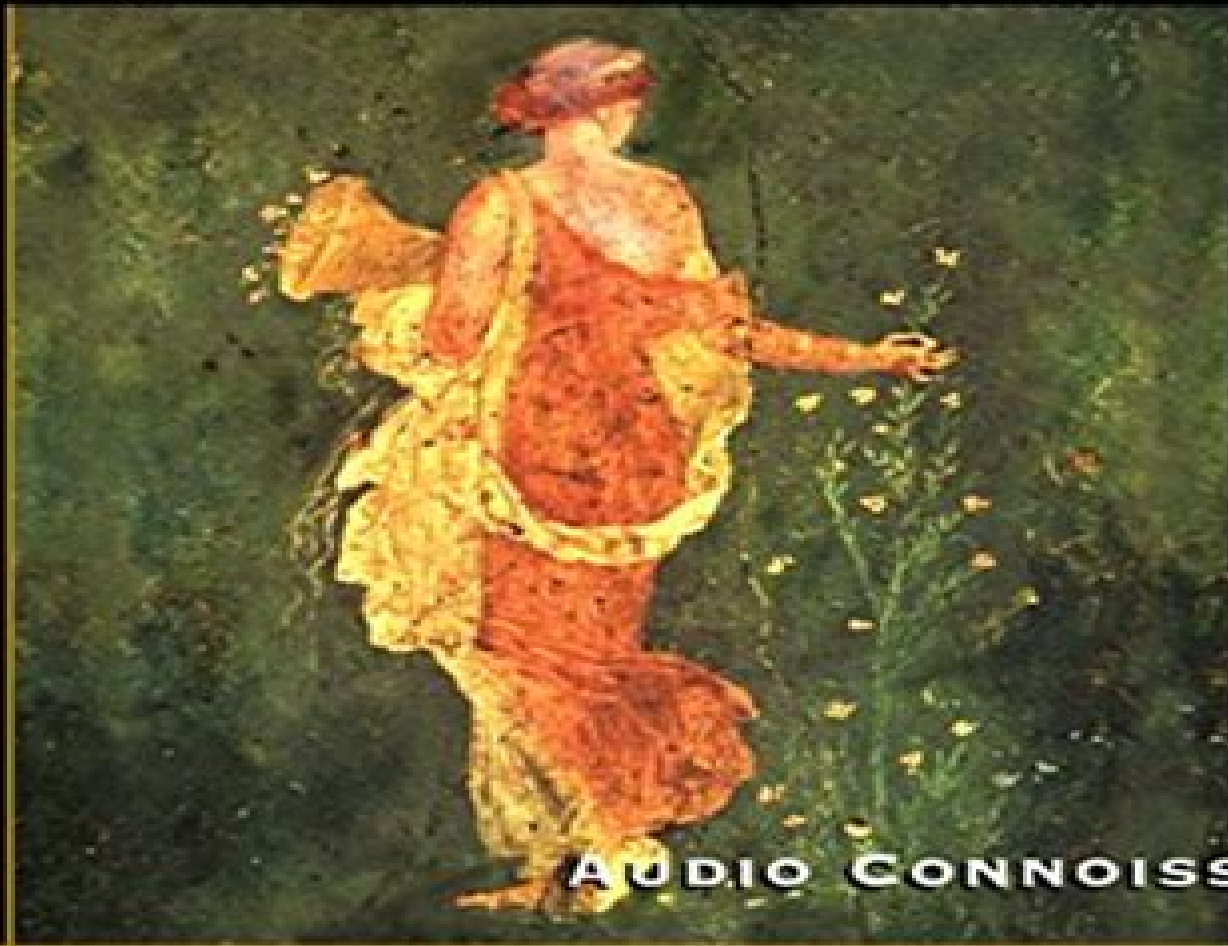

The Complete Odes and Epodes Horace, 2000 Horace 65 8 BC is one of the most important and brilliant poets of the Augustan Age of Latin literature whose influence on European literature is unparalleled Horace's Odes and Epodes constitute a body of Latin poetry equalled only by Virgil's astonishing us with leaps of sense and rich modulation masterly metaphor and exquisite subtlety The Epodes include proto Augustan poems intent on demonstrating the tolerance humour and the humanity of the new leaders of Rome robust love poems and poems of violent denunciation the Odes echo Greek lyric poetry reflecting on war politics and the gods and celebrating the pleasures of wine friendship love poetry and music Steeped in allusion to contemporary affairs Horace's verse is best read in terms of his changing relationship to the public sphere and David West's superb new translation is supplemented by a lucid introduction illuminating these complexities extensive notes a chronological survey and a glossary of names Horace: Odes Book II Horace, 2017-04-07 Horace's Odes remain among the most widely read works of classical literature This volume constitutes the first substantial commentary for a generation on this book and presents Horace's poems for a new cohort of modern students and scholars The introduction focusses on the particular features of this poetic book and its place in Horace's poetic career and in the literary environment of its particular time in the 20s BCE The text and commentary both look back to the long and distinguished tradition of Horatian scholarship and incorporate the many advances of recent research and thinking about Latin literature The volume proposes some new solutions to established problems of text and interpretation and in general improves modern understanding of a widely read ancient text which has a firm place in college and university courses as well as in classical research **The Odes of**

Dalton Quintus Horatius Flaccus, 1863 *Horace: Odes IV and Carmen Saeculare* Horace, 2011-06-23 The Carmen Saeculare was composed and published in 17 BCE as Horace was returning to the genre of lyric which he had abandoned six years earlier the fourth book of Odes is in part a response to this poem the only commissioned poem we know from the period The hardening of the political situation with the Republic a thing of the past and the Augustan succession in the air threw the problematic issue of praise into fresh relief and at the same time provided an impulse towards the nostalgia represented by the poet's private world Professor Thomas provides an introduction and commentary the first full commentary in English since the nineteenth century to each of the poems exploring their status as separate lyric artefacts and their place in the larger web of the book The edition is intended primarily for upper level undergraduates and graduate students but is also important for scholars

Horace Odes 3 Horace, David West, 2002 The aim of this book is to provide a translation and commentary which will help newcomers to Horace whether or not they know Latin to understand how the poetry works This third book of Odes begins with the Roman odes in praise of Augustus the ruthless politician who had won control over the whole known world These poems should therefore interest historians as poetic presentations of an ideology and students of literature as the work of a

man who found ways of praising while asserting his independence Part of his strategy is to follow the political odes with an array of poems on love friendship country life religion and on poetry all of them filled with delight in life and a unique sense of humour

Osburn, 2003 The Latin text of Books I and II of Horace's Odes is included along with notes for each word The notes give complete grammatical syntactical mythological geographical historical and vocabulary information A literal translation of each ode is included at the back of the book Each word is fully parsed in the notes at the bottom of each page The lines of the odes are numbered sequentially beginning with Ode 1 Book I through Ode 20 Book II The sequential numbering is a unique aid to finding the English translation of the line of Latin in the translation section at the back of the book These aids should be exceedingly helpful to teachers who are faced with the daunting task of teaching Horace's Odes especially the first time

Nisbet, Niall Rudd, 2004-05-27 This book is a successor to the commentaries by Nisbet and Hubbard on Odes I and II but it takes critical note of the abundant recent writing on Horace It starts from the precise interpretation of the Latin attention is paid to the nuances implied by the word order parallel passages are quoted not to depreciate the poet's originality but to elucidate his meaning and to show how he adapted his predecessors sometimes major English poets are cited to exemplify his influence on the tradition In expounding the so called Roman Odes the editors reject not only uncritical acceptance of Augustan ideology but also more recent attempts to find subversion in a court poet They show how Greek moralizing particularly by the Epicureans is applied to contemporary social situations Poems on country festivals are treated sympathetically in the belief that the tolerant and inclusive religion of the Romans can easily be misunderstood The poet's wit is emphasized in his addresses both to eminent Romans and to women with Greek names the latter poems are taken as reflecting his general experience rather than particular occasions Though Horace's ironic self presentation must not be understood too literally the editors reject the modern tendency to treat the author as unknowable Although the text of the Odes is not printed separately the headings to the notes provide a continuous text The editors put forward a number of conjectures most of them necessarily tentative and in the few cases where they disagree both opinions are summarized
