

EDWARD OF BRANFORD, CONN.

Edward Barker, born about 1625, was said to have come to England in 1640, and was a well known merchant in 1650. He lived in New Haven, Conn., where he carried on an extensive trade to Barbados, West Indies.

Not being in accord with the church government in the town of New Haven, forty seven men of whom Edward was one, met and signed a New Plantation & Church Covenant 1-2-1671. This Covenant was to insure the Congregational form of worship and to provide for settlement of boundary and relations. Choosing a near by locality, they selected Branford 12 miles from New Haven.

On 11-13-1671 Abraham Pierson of Newark, N. J. sold to Edward all his accommodations in Branford, including house-lot, orchard, horse pasture and other lands with a very horse without any artificial marker, very well known and seen about Channahong, receiving in payment 120 pounds. Below a man of distinction Edward was named in a
