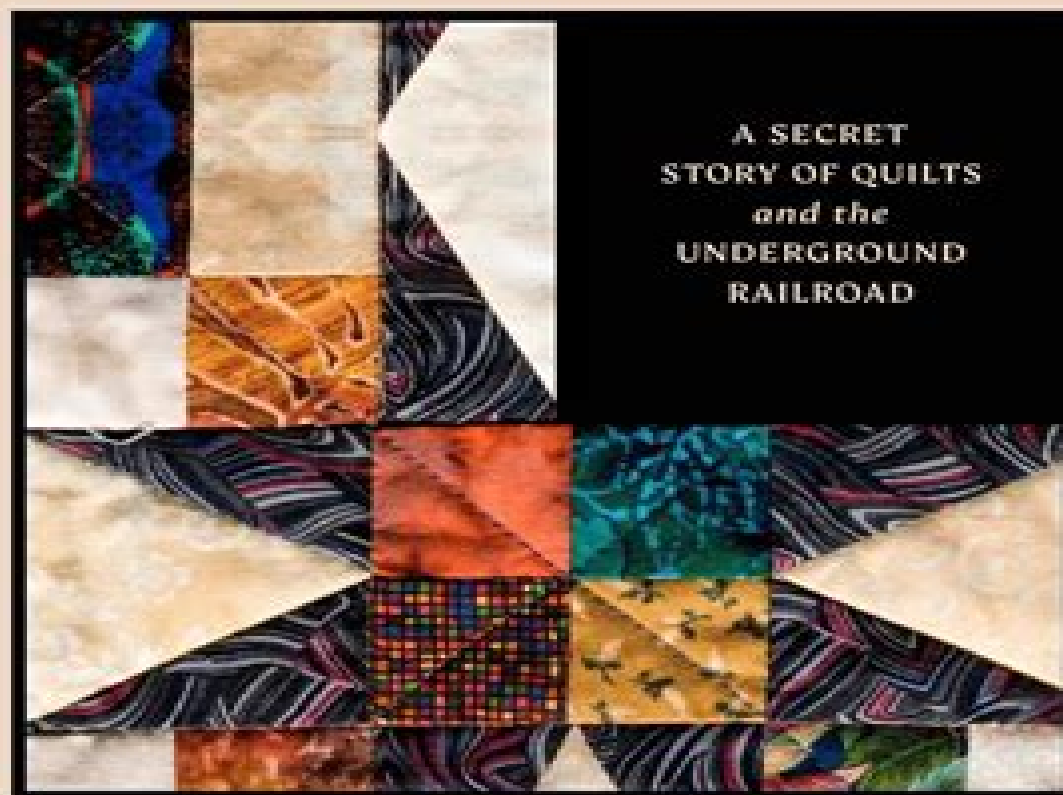

It began its tenure with little government direction; its initial approach was cautious and reactionary. However, by the turn of the century this Board, driven by some forceful individuals, was squarely focused on a legislative agenda that sought policies to control, segregate and expel Aboriginal people. Over time it acquired extraordinary powers to control Aboriginal movement, remove children from their communities and send them into domestic service, collect wages and hold them in trust, withhold rations, expel individuals from stations and reserves, authorise medical inspections and prevent any Aboriginal person from leaving the state. *Power and Dysfunction* explores this Board and uncovers who were the major drivers of these policies, who were its most influential people and how this body came to wield so much power.
