

Isolated Dwelling

An isolated dwelling is a settlement containing one or two houses, isolated dwellings are found in remote rural areas and may include outbuildings such as barns, cattle pens and holiday homes. People who live in isolated dwellings need to travel great distances to access goods and services. Sometimes goods can be sent to the place or shipped in by boat. Because of their remoteness, isolated dwellings are generally quite attractive.



Village

A village is a small settlement with a population of around hundred people. Most villages have a central area that will contain some of the most important, usually at least a shop or two, a school or three small businesses. There are houses, a primary school and facilities. Villages are good settlements and often make good locations for other villages.



City

A city is a large settlement with a population of hundreds of thousands of people. Most cities have excellent opportunities, usually shops and shopping centres. Many people choose to live in the city because they can find a high rate of return in the city. Most cities have a central area that will contain some of the most important, usually at least a shop or two, a school or three small businesses. There are houses, a primary school and facilities. Villages are good settlements and often make good locations for other villages.



Hamlet

A hamlet is a very small settlement with a population of less than a hundred people. Hamlets do not have any shops or houses. They may have a small facility such as a community hall. People living in hamlets must travel to nearby towns or cities to find what they need. There are very small settlements. There are no services or facilities available. Hamlets are often small settlements with very little traffic from one end of the village.



Town

A town is a medium sized settlement with a population of around thousand people. Most towns have excellent opportunities, as well as other facilities such as shops and houses. Most people who live in the town can work locally. Services such as schools and hospitals are present in the town, along with shops facilities such as shopping centre, parks and squares. Residential areas of the town are usually built on higher ground around the shops and business.
