Endgames Albrecht Wellmer, 1998 A common theme of this set of thirteen essays by one of the major figures in contemporary German philosophy is the idea of a postmetaphysical modernity In his preface Wellmer relates the title of his book *Endgames* to this common theme The historical utopias of the Marxist tradition and the programs of ultimate justification in the Kantian tradition are both endgames within metaphysics the deconstruction of those utopias and programs of ultimate justification are endgames played with metaphysics and the game with an end as ultimate telos the end s of history the end s of knowledge the end s of human life is metaphysics The title *Endgames* finally also refers polemically to postmodernist games with an end of modernity as opposed to these Wellmer defends the fragile moral and political substance of the modernity that postmodernists attempt to overcome and that sense of what needs to be preserved of the modern tradition for a postmetaphysical modernity is what makes his writings unique In the first of the book s three parts *Negative and Communicative Freedom* Wellmer focuses on political philosophy examining in particular the links and tensions between liberal basic rights and modern ideas of democracy In Part II *Postmetaphysical Perspectives* he attempts to develop a postmetaphysical perspective on aesthetics and metaphysics with and against Adorno on the problem of truth with and against Richard Rorty Jürgen Habermas and Karl Otto Apel and on hermeneutics with and against Hans Georg Gadamer and Karl Otto Apel Part III *Images of the Times* contains occasional pieces on Ludwig Wittgenstein the Frankfurt School Hans Jonas and architecture The book closes with an appended critical essay on Hannah Arendt reflecting the importance of Arendt s political philosophy to Wellmer s work

In this book Gustavo Pereira offers an account of such phenomena by defining them as a cognitive failure that affects the practical imagination thus negatively interfering with our practical life. This failure of the imagination is the consequence of the imposition of a type of practical rationality on a practical context alien to it caused by a non-conscious transformation of the individual's set of beliefs and values. The research undertaken provides an innovative explanation in terms of microfoundations based on the mechanism of availability heuristic by which the diminished exercise of the imagination turns the intuitively available or prevailing rationality into the one that regulates behaviour in inappropriate contexts. Additionally, this incorrect regulation results in a progressive distortion of the shared sense of the affected practical contexts which becomes institutionalized. Consumerism, bureaucratism, moralism, juridification, some forms of corruption and the particular Latin American case of malinchism can be interpreted as social pathologies insofar as they imply such distortion. This way of conceptualizing social pathologies integrates the traditional sociological macro-explanation manifested through the negative consequences of the processes of social rationalization with a micro-explanation articulated around the findings of cognitive psychology such as availability heuristic. Understanding social pathologies as a cognitive failure allows us to identify the introduction of normative friction as the main way to counteract their effects. One of the potential effects of normative friction as a specific form of cognitive dissonance is the intense exercise of the imagination thus operating as a condition of possibility for the exercise of autonomy and reflection. Democratic ethical life understood as a shared democratic culture as well as social institutions and narratives are the privileged social spaces and means to trigger reflective processes that can counteract social pathologies through a reflective reappropriation of the meaning of the shared practical context.
